ELIGIBILITY

The Italian U23 Open is open to all players above the age of 17 and under the age of 23 on the 14th of February 2016 (final scheduled date of the event)

SEEDING

The seeding will be carried out using the PSA world rankings and the European Junior Ranking valid at the closing date. Any players without a ranking will be seeded by the Tournament Director.

DRAWS - PSA CLOSED SATELLITE

Maximum draw size Boys U23: 32 players Maximum draw size Girls U23: 32 players

On Sunday the matches for positions 9+ (out of the top 8) are only played if both players agree to play. The tournament office must be informed about the agreement within 30 min after the last round on Saturday.

MATCHES

All matches played will consist of the best of five sets, under the rules of the WSF. All players are guaranteed a minimum of three matches. PAR 11 scoring (to clear 2 points) will be used.

REFEREEING

All players will be expected to mark and referee matches

BALL

The Dunlop Pro XX ball will be used.

PRACTICE COURTS

Practice facilities will be provided by the organiser and will be available at the venue starting the day before the tournament (fees could apply).

ESF REGULATIONS

This tournament is part of the ESF Under 23 Circuit and will be run in accordance with the ESF U23 Guidelines, a copy of which is available on the ESF website at www.europeansquash.com. All players must have an active, paid-for SPIN (Squash Personal Identification Number) to participate. Please visit www.worldsquash.org/spin to register. Players will need to be endorsed by their National Federation.

DOPE TESTING

The ESF and the hosts reserve the right to implement compulsory dope testing for any player participating in the Championships. Dope testing may be carried out in line with the doping regulations published by the WSF. Member nations are responsible for informing all their participants (including managers, coaches and physiotherapists) about the latest WSF policy on doping; and must impose the standard WSF suspension from all forms of competitive squash upon a player who has used banned substances or practices.
